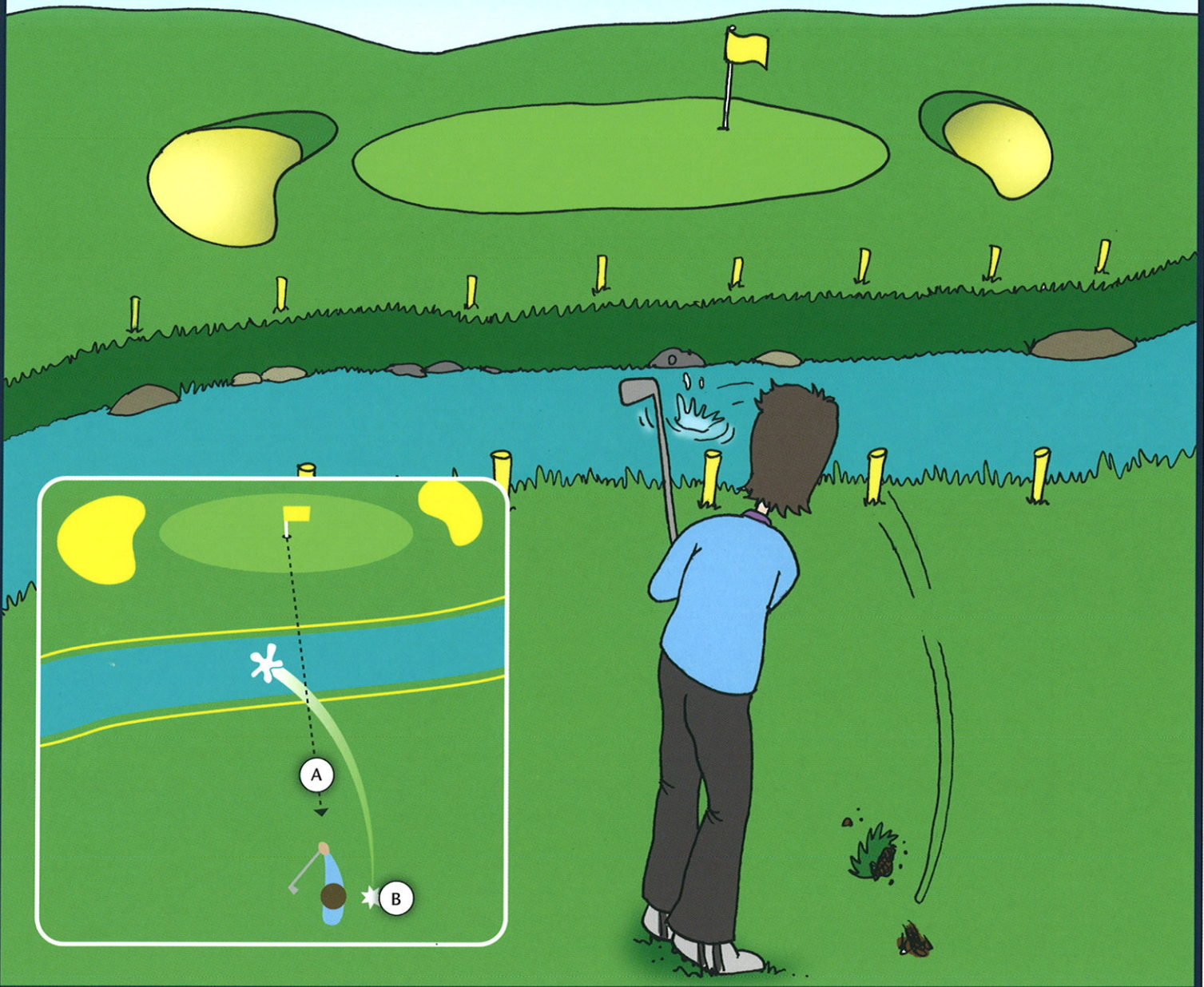

Scottish Golf Union Rules Reminder 11

Ball in or Lost in a Water Hazard



WHAT ARE YOUR OPTIONS?

You may play your original ball as it lies without penalty or under penalty of one stroke:

- (A) Drop a ball behind the hazard anywhere on the extension of the line from the the hole through the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard
- (B) Play a ball from where the last shot was played (see Rule 20-5)
