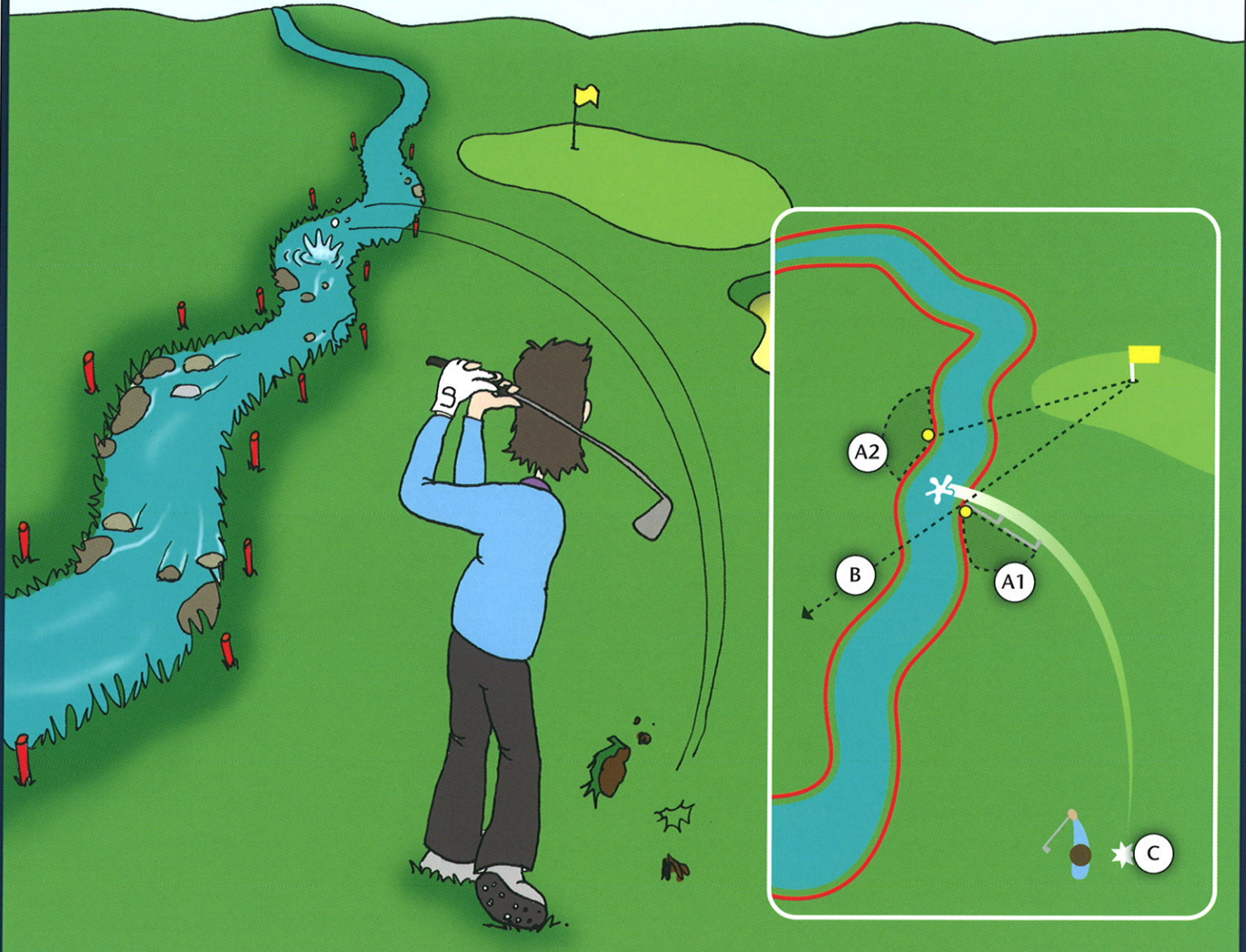

# Scottish Golf Union Rules Reminder 12

## Ball in or Lost in a Lateral Water Hazard



### WHAT ARE YOUR OPTIONS?

You may play your original ball as it lies without penalty or under penalty of one stroke:

- (A) Drop a ball within 2 club lengths of, but not nearer the hole than
  - (A1) the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard or
  - (A2) the point on the opposite margin of the water hazard equidistant from the hole
- (B) Drop a ball behind the hazard anywhere on the extension of the line from the hole through the point where the ball entered the hazard or
- (C) Play a ball from where the last shot was played (see Rule 20-5)
