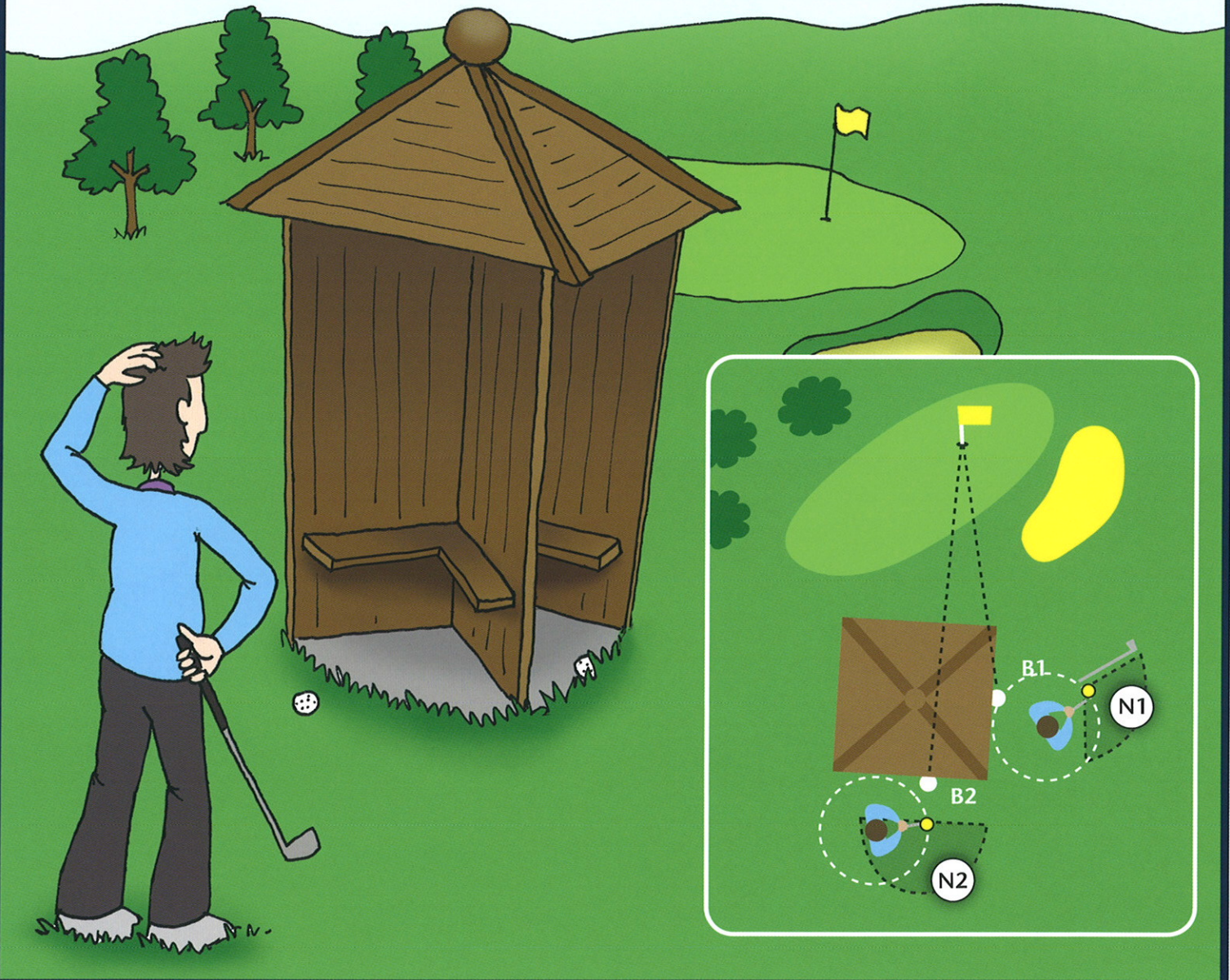


Immovable Obstruction



Relief from an immovable obstruction

If your ball is in or on the obstruction (B1) or the obstruction interferes with your stance or area of your intended swing (B2) you may without penalty:

Identify the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole than where the ball lay ((N1) or (N2)) and drop the ball within one club length of, but not nearer the hole than, that point.

This will give you relief from the obstruction but not necessarily for your line of play.
