Scottish Golf Union Rules Reminder 5

Ground Under Repair (Play Prohibited)



To protect specific areas of the course (e.g. young trees) the Committee may declare these as 'Ground Under Repair - Play Prohibited'.

Complete relief from interference to the lie of the ball, your stance or your area of intended swing in these areas, must be taken. The nearest point which provides such relief must be determined and the ball lifted and dropped without penalty within one club length of, and not nearer the hole than, that point.

If, however, an area of ground under repair has not been declared as 'Play Prohibited' under a Local Rule then you are entitled to play your original ball as it lies.
